

Summary:

- 1. 575 responses were received from various departments, which were then analyzed to arrive at the following interpretations.
- 2. The respondents' ages ranged from 17 to 25 years...
- 3. Among the 575 respondents, 87.5% were pursuing undergraduate graduation and 12.5% were pursuing postgraduate education.
- 4. Out of 575 responders, 28% were from the UG Science stream, 59.5% from the UG Arts stream, 13.3% from the PG Arts stream, and 4.5 from the PG Science stream.
- 5. When asked about the extent of the curriculum covered in class, the responses revealed that 70.6% responded, 85 to 100% were covered, while 25% indicated, 70 to 84% were covered.
- 6. Students' perceptions of teachers' preparedness for classes found that 51% felt that professors were completely prepared for classes, while 45.6% were just satisfied.
- 7. 51% of respondents thought the teachers' communication abilities were always effective, 33.2% thought they were somewhat effective, and 0.9% thought they were very poor.
- 8. Respondents evaluated the teacher's teaching method, and the results show that 46.3% thought it was excellent and 35.7% thought it was very good.
- 9. In response to the instructors' question about the fairness of the internal evaluation procedure, 50.6% of the students indicated it was always fair, 36.5% mentioned it was generally fair, and 0.5% said it was unfair.
- 10. Review and feedback of student assignments is a common element in the institution; in response to a question about it, students stated that it was done every time (49.7%), usually

- (35.3%), and occasionally (12.3%), indicating that the majority of students confirmed the existence of regular review and feedback.
- 11. The College supports internship and field trip opportunities for students to challenge the efforts of instructors in this regard; the students affirmed that it was alone on a regular basis (43.8%), often (33.3%), and sometimes (16.5%). Thus, the majority of responders participated in promoting internships and planning field trips.
- 12. The teaching and mentoring process at the college helps students' cognitive, social, and emotional growth. When asked about this, students responded that the institution does so significantly (38.3%), very well (44.7%), and moderately (13.4%). As a result, the majority of respondents believed that the college made a significant contribution.
- 13. 38.3% of respondents strongly agreed that the college gives several possibilities to study and improve, 43.5% agreed, and 16% were neutral.
- 14. Teachers are required to enlighten students about course and programme outcomes; when asked about this, the respondents plummeted. Every time (47.5%), usually (23.7%), and sometimes (10.1%), the majority of respondents agreed that teachers educated their students about skills, course outcomes, and program outcomes.
- 15. When asked about mentors' efforts, 86.9% agreed that it was done always and usually (10.8%).
- 16. According to 88.5% of respondents, teachers demonstrate topics using examples and applications.
- 17. According to 88.1% of respondents, the faculty identify students' abilities and encourage them by giving appropriate levels of challenge, whereas 9% believe it was done to a reasonable partially.
- 18. In response to a question about teachers' efforts to recognize pupils' weaknesses and provide assistance in overcoming those, 61.9% stated it was always done, while 27.6% said it was usually done.
- 19. According to 84.5% of respondents, the college has students monitor and analyse the Teaching and Learning process.
- 20. In response to a question about faculty's usage of student-centric methods such as experiential learning, participatory methods such as experiential learning, and problem solving

in classrooms, the responses revealed the following: 84.7% of respondents agreed that the above-mentioned 13% had moderate use. As a result, the majority of respondents supported the use of students in the classroom.

- 21. Extracurricular activities are a significant aspect of college life; 46.8% strongly believe that teachers encourage students to participate in extracurricular activities, while 40.2% agree.
- 22. About 86.6% of respondents agreed that the college makes significant efforts to improve soft skills, life skills, and employability skills.
- 23. The survey found that teachers utilize ICT tools more than 90% (40.9%) and between 70 and 89% (33.9%), implying that teachers are increasingly adopting ICT tools when teaching.

Suggestions

More student-centric methods shall be implemented. Extracurricular activities, soft skills, and employability skills need to be improved further. Specific programs for slow and advanced learners should be implemented. The use of multimedia and LCD projectors needs to be improved.

Action taken report

Students need to be encouraged to use more learner-centered methods, such as experiential learning, and problem-solving analysis. More soft skills, employability skills, and life skill training to be provided via Add-On and Certificate courses. Walk-the-scholar and scholar assistance initiatives have to be implemented to identify and encourage advanced and slow learners. More faculty development programs, orientation, and refresher courses on the use of ICT technologies in the teaching-learning process to be planned.
