General Observations:

- The institution is a government-aided, coeducational college affiliated to Manonsnaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli. It holds a CGPA of 2.92 and has received NAAC accreditation for the second cycle.
- The management and principal follow a progressive vision, supported by a decentralized administrative structure with a well-defined action plan.
- The faculty comprises both esperienced and newly appointed members who are qualified and dedicated, adhering to institutional quality standards.
- The college offers 9 undergraduate, 4 postgraduate, and 4 research programs.
- There are 69 faculty members (38 doctorates), 12 administrative and 11 supporting staff. The institution has a total student enrollment of 745.
- It offers two certificate courses (Certificate course in Rubber Technology & Certificate course in Library and Information Science). Additionally, there is 1 institutional MoU and 3 MoUs related to extension activities.
- An active Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) is in place, and the institution is preparing for its third NAAC accreditation cycle.
- The library is well-equipped with adequate facilities.

College Office

- Periodic surveillance audits are conducted and records are updated.
- Fee payments are made at the office, via online banking system.

Programmes, Curriculum, and Supportive Courses

- Additional programs, particularly at the postgraduate level, are introduced to align with NEP guidelines and stakeholder needs.
- Each department maintains specific records related to curriculum activities such as remedial classes, tutorials, bridge courses, industrial visits, and educational tours.
- Cross-cutting issues are documented separately and clearly identified.

Suggestion

- All departments must implement a more student-focused approach.
- The feedback process should be carried out following IQAC recommendations.
- Departments should establish a system to monitor the quality of supportive courses like certificate programs, skill training, spoken English and value education.

Teaching Learning and Evaluation

- All teachers undergo structured and planned training in both academic and extracurricular duties.
- Professional skill development for both teaching and non-teaching staff are given priority to enhance the quality of education on campus.
- > Teachers are encouraged to explore and participate in activities that provide national and international exposure.
- ➤ The tutorial system, especially at the undergraduate level, enhances the learning experience. Continuous evaluation and formative assessments are implemented to monitor student progress

Suggestion

- ➤ Additional training is necessary for teachers, with proper evaluation and analysis of outcomes.
- > The current curriculum feedback system should be enhanced for better effectiveness, with IQAC providing guidelines to departments through curriculum audits.

Research and Extension

- > Research activities on campus are encouraged, with a recommendation to establish additional research centers.
- > All departments are involved in a extension activities and systematic sensitization programs for students in specific communities are organized.

Suggestion

- > A strong research culture should be fostered throughout the institution.
- > The Innovation Centre should focus on promoting research and development with a student-centered approach.
- > Both faculty and student publications need improvement.
- > Faculty members can effectively implement institutional policies in their research and publications.

Administrative Staff

Suggestion

- > Training opportunities may be extended to all administrative & supporting staff.
- > Training should be offered to enhance e-governance.
- > Additional IT skill development programs to be provided for administrative staff.
- > Annual soft skills training to be conducted to improve interactions between students and faculty.

Governance

- The institution's vision and mission are integrated into the planning process.
- An inclusive management system has been established.
- A development plan and policy document are in place and are being executed as intended.
- Staff are provided with appropriate welfare measures.
- > Student Teacher Evaluations and PBAS have been processed effectively.
- ▶ Both teaching and non-teaching staff have completed specific professional training.

Suggestion

The fund mobilization cell requires further strengthening.

Infrastructure

- Despite space constraints, significant efforts have been made to include all essential facilities.
- Additional land has been acquired as a part of institution's growth plan.
- > Several resources, such as the language lab and ICT laboratory are to be utilised effectively.
- Appropriate facilities are provided for individuals with physical disabilities.
- > ICT resources are limited, but used effectively.
- > The integration of modern amenities is impressive.

Student Support and Progression

> Students health is being monitored in collaboration with the primary health center in Vadasery.

Suggestion

- ➤ Further emphasis should be placed on skill development with potential collaborations with external agencies like the Skill Development Corporation of India and Tamilnadu Government Naan Mudhalvan Skill Development Programme.
- > A monitoring committee should be established to assess the quality of the institution's add-on or certificate courses

Library

- The overall atmosphere of the college library is satisfactory.
- > An improved reading ambience is commendable.
- Digital remote access and online repositories are helpful in fulfilling the demand for online reference materials.

Suggestion

- More events to be organized to enhance students' overall development.
- > A structured process has to be established to ensure the efficient functioning of these clubs and fora.

Departmental Observations

- The staff room offers a pleasant working environment.
- Stock registers are verified by the HoD and Principal.
- Departmental records need to be updated with proper formatting.
- The chemical waste management system is effective and fully operational.
- Compilation of annual report effectively summarizing all activities from the previous year is done effectively.
- Current tutorial and remedial classes are inadequate.

Suggestion

- > Communication with universities regarding the curriculum should be documented.
- Certificate programs for students should be initiated
- > The use of ICT in curriculum delivery should be encouraged.
- > Documentation is needed to track the percentage of cross-cutting issues included in the curriculum.
- > The departments could introduce quality enhancement programs for staff in enhancing language skills.
- > Future planning for the development of department is necessary and more extension activities should be initiated.

NSS, NCC, Clubs, and Committees

- > Sensitization programs to be introduced for students.
- > To undertake socially relevant projects, partnerships with the community and strong student-community relationships should be fostered.
- Documentation must be properly maintained and aligned with the institutional standards.

IQAC

The following initiatives are proposed:

- > Staff training on NEP awareness and compiling data/proof using the updated NAAC format.
- Training on a standardized documentation system.
- > Workshops on implementing OBE, curriculum development, and mentorship.
- ➤ Enhancing student awareness of NAAC and promoting their involvement.

- The quality initiatives and future plans of IQAC has to be systematically planned.
- IQAC will ensure that all departments, cells, clubs, NSS, NCC etc. maintain a comprehensive record of all activities conducted in the college.

General Suggestions


- Overall quality in areas such as personal and professional development, infrastructure, student outcomes, and administration has to be enhanced.
- > The development plan to be updated to align with NEP requirements.
- > IQAC should provide standardized formats for student attendance, activity reports, continuous evaluation, and outcome analysis.
- > IQAC to implement measures to improve instructors' interactive capabilities.
- ➤ Monthly test papers should be used for formative assessments to meet CIE standards, and all students to be covered by insurance.
- > Specific training programs in areas like OBE, curriculum delivery, student-centred activities, professional skills, counselling, evaluation systems, accreditation, NET preparation, career advancement, content creation, ICT, and curriculum design should be offered.
- > Research collaboration and faculty exchange programs to be promoted.
- ➤ A clear framework to be established for remedial, instructional, and bridge courses.



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
